The government wants to attract more foreign tourists to visit museums and other cultural facilities throughout Japan, so it's decided to write a new law, said people (13) knew about the plan on Dec. 16.

The law would let the government give subsidies to facilities to improve access.

The aim would be to increase the number of tourists to (14) areas and promote Japanese culture and history, they said.

The facilities would also get money for improvements such as Wi-Fi reception, multilingual services and (15) payments for tickets, the sources said.

The government hopes the law will help the number of foreign visitors (16) 40 million in 2020 and 60 million in 2030.

It will choose around 25 places across the country for the subsidies. The first year's budget will be around ¥2 billion, the sources said. The government expects to give the Diet a bill for the scheme in January, they said.
